What?

A visit of the Viaduc the more tallest in the world indoor and outdoor

Where?

Meeting point on the Viaduc Expo's rest area (outdoor parking)

How do I get there?

Go through the roundabout called « Giratoire des Bergers » in « Millau - Saint-Germain » (Entrance A75 Hightway - Millau Nord) and then follow the « Aire du Viaduc de Millau » (rest area) direction

When?

Friday 12th june 2020 at 14h00, 15h30 or 17h00 Saturday 13th june 2020 at 09h00 or 10h30

Who?

TAWARA competitors, their accompanying persons and the volunteers who contributed to the organization (aged 12 and above)

How do I register?

What should I bring?

Proof of identification (ID card, passport...), wear flat closed shoes. You will be lent a helmet for the duration of the « tablier »'s visit.

GET READY!

RUN & PADDLE

Start: from La Malène beach. First, you will run on the left path of the Tarn (3.5 K) until you reach the village called Hauterives. In Hauterives, you will have to cross the Tarn while walking or swimming (completely up to you) in order to reach your kayak or SUP which will be waiting for you on the right bank of the river (road side). The finish line will be located on the La Malène's beach, 3 K downstream.

Mandatory equipment for the entire race: running shoes, life jacket and bib. Helmet for the aquatic portion of the race.

SPRINT RACE 18 K ENDURANCE RACE 67 K

Start: All the kayaks will start from the bridge, in the water. As for the SUP, they will start from the beach. They will be aligned on the whole width of the beach, next to each other.

LAU

will be waiting for you on the right bank of the river (road side). The finish line will be located on the La Malène's beach, 3 K downstream.

Mandatory equipment: closed shoes, wetsuit (in case of foul weather), helmet, life jacket, mobile phone and bib. You will also be entrusted a GPS beacon. Make sur to keep it all the way. Your safety and our responsibility are at stake.

WATERCRAFTS LAUNCHING ON THE 18 K AND 66 K

If I come with the shuttle, it will be in St-Chélydu-Tarn => Saint-Chély-du-Tarn

If I come by car, make sure to park in the village of Sainte-Enimie (4,8 K upstream the start line) and launch from there, since the village of Saint-Chély-du-Tarn won't be able accommodate all the vehicles. Hence, plan to launch at 7.30 am the lasted so you won't miss the start.
